2. Accreditation and Practical Information

Only media representatives who have obtained prior online accreditation with the Federal Press Service are allowed access to the media events of this programme and to use the media centre in the Hofburg.

Online accreditation can be carried out directly on the website of the Austrian Presidency at <u>https://www.eu2018.at/media/Media-accreditation.html</u>.

The accreditation badge is valid for the entire duration of the Austrian Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

The online accreditation system contains a **list of all the events** for which you can register. Please register in advance for the event you wish to attend.

2.1. Accreditation Desk

You can collect your accreditation badge Monday to Friday from 9:00 to 13:00 from the Media Accreditation Office of the Federal Press Service (Schauflergasse 1, 1010 Vienna).

Monday to Friday: from 09:00 to 13:00

Between 28 and 31 August 2018, the media accreditation office can be found in event room 2 situated off the Amalienhof courtyard of the Hofburg, Ballhausplatz 1. Event room 2 is located on right-hand side of the courtyard.

Collection times for accreditation badges at the media accreditation desk:

To collect your accreditation badge, you will need to present three documents: your accreditation confirmation, a valid press card or the original letter of assignment from your media organisation, and a government-issued photo identification (identity card, passport or driving licence).

2.2. POOL Sessions

For organisational purposes we have to schedule the following events as POOL sessions:

- POOL 1: Group photo, followed by tour-de-table 30 August 2018 at 16:15
- POOL 2: Group photo with the ministers of the EU candidate countries 31 August 2018 at 10:10

To attend pool sessions, you will need not only a valid accreditation badge, but also a pool card. You can apply as of now for a pool card by emailing <u>pk-anmeldungen@bmeia.gv.at</u>.

Registration for pool sessions ends at 15:00 on Tuesday 28 August 2018.

The Ministry for Foreign Affairs reserves the right to close registration for pool sessions once all the places have been allocated. Places will be allocated on a first-come first-served basis. Should the number of registrations exceed the number of places, only those media representatives who have <u>not been allocated a place</u> on the pool list will receive an email notification.

The pool cards that give access to the pool sessions of the programme **can be collected exclusively from the information desk of the media centre in the Hofburg.**


3.2. Access

3.3. Entrance for Media

The media centre is located on the ground floor of the Hofburg. It can be accessed via the entrance in the Burgpassage (via Heldenplatz).

3.6. Parking

In the immediate vicinity of the Hofburg Vienna, no parking spaces have been reserved for media representatives. Please use the public underground car parks in

the surrounding area, such as the Opera car park or the Freyung car park. Please note the short-term parking regulations in Vienna.

3.7. Information Desk

An information desk for media representatives has been set up in Gardehalle II on the ground floor of the Hofburg.

- general information
- daily agenda and updates

The information desk is open during the opening hours of the media centre and is also a meeting point for the media events. You must arrive no later than the time specified in the media programme in order to take part in a particular media event.

3.8. Equipment

The media centre has three briefing rooms, 200 workstations for media representatives and offers the following equipment:

- desks and chairs
- 220V power supply at each workstation
- Wi-Fi
- limited number of LAN access points
- Iimited number of ISDN access points
- limited number of permanent PCs in the media centre
- printer and copy machine black/white
- lounge area

3.9. Stand-Up Positions

A limited number of stand-up positions are available both inside and outside the media centre. Bookings can be made directly with the host broadcaster.

3.10. Catering

Coffee stations can be found in the media centre in the Hofburg. You can pick up free drinks here during the media centre opening hours. There will also be a buffet lunch in the media area on 30 and 31 August as well as a dinner on the first floor of the Hofburg on 30 August.

3.11. Please Note

- During the Austrian Presidency, video recordings, audio recordings and photos featuring attendees may be taken. This material may be shared by the Austrian Presidency or the Austrian Federal Government including on their websites or social media channels. By attending events, attendees agree to this material being published on an unlimited basis.
- Workstations in the media centres are allocated on a first-come first-served basis. Event organisers are unable to reserve workstations for media representatives. The Austrian Presidency team will remove from unoccupied workstations any reserved signs placed there by media representatives an hour after the start of an event.
- The Austrian Presidency assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to property.
- Taking photos or making recordings of confidential documents or other property belonging to attendees (including with mobile phones) is strictly forbidden.
- Under no circumstances are security staff to be filmed or photographed.
- The Federal Press Service reserves the right, should the need arise, to confiscate accreditation badges and thus revoke accreditation.
- Items which are not allowed to be brought into the media centre in accordance with the house rules or for security reasons may be handed over for safekeeping to the security team members in the entrance area of the media centre.
- Lost property will be kept at the information desk in the media centre. If the owner can be identified, the organisational team of the Austrian Presidency will contact the owner. Any uncollected items will be handed over to the Lost and Found Service of the City of Vienna.

4. Host Services

4.1. Host Broadcaster

ORF (Austrian Broadcasting Corporation) is the host broadcaster for the Austrian Presidency. and will provide free of charge to any interested Austrian or international radio stations and television channels **audiovisual material in broadcast quality (HD)** on this informal ministerial meeting.

Audiovisual material will be broadcast via EbS, the European Union's TV information service (programme: <u>http://ec.europa.eu/avservices/ebs/schedule.cfm</u>, satellite reception: <u>http://ec.europa.eu/avservices/ebs/satellite.cfm?sitelang=en</u>) and can be downloaded in real time via the website of the European Commission's Audiovisual Services at <u>https://ec.europa.eu/avservices/</u>.

The live feed of the audiovisual material can be received in the TV and radio booths and the parking spaces for satellite news gathering trucks (SNGs) at the media centre. Additional broadcasting requirements should be notified to the host broadcaster and will incur charges.

The host broadcaster will provide the following audiovisual material:

- arrivals and doorsteps in original language version
- handshakes (host welcome) in original language version
- tour-de-table
- Austrian Presidency press conference (original language version as well as German, English and French)

With regards to current coverage, rights of use are not limited in time or space.

The Austrian Presidency will make available 12 **TV and radio booths** in the media centre. The standard fitting includes one basic ISDN access point (radio booths), one LAN access point, 220V power supply and four workstations. Any additional requirements should be notified to the host broadcaster and will incur charges.

The host broadcaster will also provide the following services:

- technical support
- registration for and allocation of stand-up positions
- registration for and allocation of TV and radio booths
- registration for and allocation of SNGs

Parking Spaces for SNGs

A limited number of parking spaces for SNGs will be provided in the immediate vicinity of the entrance to the media centre in the Hofburg. 5.3. How to Get to Vienna

By Plane

Numerous European cities offer daily flights to Vienna Airport. A welcome desk will be set up in the arrivals hall of the airport for the Gymnich meeting on 30 and 31 August 2018.

By Train

Information on train schedules and ticket prices can be obtained from the Austrian Federal Railways (ÖBB) (+43 5 1717, <u>www.oebb.at</u>) or WESTbahn (+43 1 899 00, <u>www.westbahn.at</u>).

By Car

In Austria, all drivers wishing to travel on motorways and expressways are required to pay a toll charge or have a toll sticker. Digital vignettes or toll stickers can be purchased from more than 6 000 sales outlets in Austria and abroad and can be bought for the following durations: 10 days (EUR 9), 2 months (EUR 26.20) or 1 year (EUR 87.30). Please note that the speed limit on Austrian motorways is 130 km/h.

There is a statutory drink driving limit of <0.5 milligrams of alcohol per millilitre of blood.

5.4. Connections between Vienna Airport and the City Centre

Railjet Service ÖBB

The Austrian Federal Railways (ÖBB) run a service connecting Vienna Airport with Vienna Hauptbahnhof (main station) in 15 minutes. There are regular direct connections between 06:30 and 23:00. There are indirect connections (taking approximately 40 minutes and with one change) from 04:42 to 00:18.

The U1 underground line provides a direct connection between the main station and Stephansplatz (approximately 5 minutes).

Airport Shuttle Service

The City Airport Train (CAT) offers a direct connection between Vienna Airport and the city centre in 16 minutes (Wien Mitte train station – Bahnhof Wien Mitte).

The Vienna Airport Line 2 offers a direct bus service between Vienna Airport and Morzinplatz (Schwedenplatz) station every 30 minutes. The journey will take approximately 25 minutes. Tickets can be bought on the bus.

5.5. Public Transport in Vienna

Vienna has a fully integrated public transport network. Between Monday and Friday, the underground, trams and buses run from approximately 05:00 until just after midnight. On Friday and Saturday as well as on the days preceding public holidays, the underground also runs throughout the night. Both during the week and at the weekend, NightLine buses complement the existing services as of midnight.
